

**CLARENCE FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1**  
**OSHA SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS AND TRAINING**

- I. **SCOPE:**  
This policy applies to all active firepersons in the Clarence Fire Company.
  
- II. **OBJECTIVE:**  
The objective of this policy is to set forth guidelines regarding OSHA and Health Standard Training in the Clarence Fire Company.
  
- III. **DISTRICT GUIDELINES:**
  - A. It will be mandatory to provide OSHA and Health Standard Training to all active firepersons during a calendar year.
  - B. “All active firepersons” assigned to fire fighting and fire police duties will receive eight hours of training.
  - C. These requirements will be known as OSHA “A” and OSHA “B” for identification purposes.
  - D. This mandatory training will be conducted as drill credit and must be verified by the Chief’s Office.
  
- IV. This policy rescinds the Clarence Fire District No. 1 policy regarding OSHA training dated February 6, 1995.
  
- V. This policy is adopted effective May 13, 2002.
